1. What illustrations do you find in Chapter 6 about your relationship to sin, now that you are a believer?

How do these illustrations affect your attitude toward sin in your life?

2. (Vs 13 NLT) What does it mean for you to “give yourself completely to God”? (It may be helpful to list as many different ways as you can that this command is expressed in different Bible versions.)
3. List some results of living a sinful lifestyle and contrast those results with the benefits of living a life set apart for God.

(Vs 21-23) How can knowing the “wages of sin” and the gifts and blessings of living for God help you make better choices?

4. The words “wages” and “gift” are found in verse 23. What significance do you see in the terminology used (wages/gift) for the results of the two opposing lifestyles presented in this chapter as summed up in this verse?
