Doctrinal & personal application questions:

"For (Goes does not overlook sin and) the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who in their wickedness suppress and stifle the truth," (Romans 1:18 AMP). After a careful reading of this verse, what do you perceive is the significance of the object of God's wrath being "ungodliness and unrighteousness"? Does God hate sin or does He hate sinners? Why is this distinction important?

In view of the rottenness of sin as it permeates our present culture, write down any thoughts that occur to you about the "preserving" nature of the "saltiness" of your life (see Matthew 5:13). What are the implications for you regarding your influence in your home and beyond your home?
