1. Read verse 18 with 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 and 2 Cor. 6:4-10. Why would Paul have the right to expect his readers to listen to his words about suffering?
2. Describe what the writer means by “creation” in verse 19. List ways that you see the creation subject to frustration today.
3. From verses 22-26, list the three entities that “groan” in these verses and suggest the reasons each would groan.
4. Who besides the Holy Spirit is interceding for you today? How does the truth that the Spirit prays for believers encourage you?
