

## **Romans 8:28-39 Additional Questions**

1. What does the fact that God “foreknew” you mean to you? (vs.29) See also Jeremiah 1:5 for further understanding.

2. Paul wrote “What shall we say about such wonderful things as these (vs.31a, NLT). Write out your response to “these things” that you read in verses 28-30.

3. What does it mean to you that Jesus is at the right hand of God, interceding for you? (vs. 34)

4. After reading and meditating on verses 28-39, what can you do or what circumstance of your life can ultimately harm you, defeat you or make God stop loving you? (It’s a “trick” question and a VERY short answer, but it’s EXTREMELY important.)

How does this knowledge help you face the present and the future?

What might your anxiety about the present and the future say about what you truly believe about God’s love and power?
